

Confirmation Requirements Checklist

- Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation.
- Attend and participate in Religious Education Class and all scheduled activities, including retreats.
- Complete all assignments given in class, including homework, quizzes, and tests.
- Attend Mandatory Confirmation Meetings.

Have the Candidate's Sponsor complete the Sponsor Form (or its equivalent) and return it to the Religious Education office. (Due NO LATER THAN: March 6, 2023)

Gown order form (Due: March 13, 2023)

Letter to Pastor (Due: March 27, 2023)

Apostolic Project Summary (Due: April 17, 2023)

Confirmation Test: April 24, 2023

Confirmation Rehearsal, with a parent or his/her Sponsor. (Spring 2023)

***Note:** ALL of the requirements stated above, along with any and all assignments given in class, MUST be completed before your child will be allowed to be Confirmed.

Religious Education Classes **(RE) Attendance**

Classes start at 6 pm, please make sure your child arrives to class on time. If they show up 5 minutes late or later, they will be marked tardy. Please note that 3 tardies is equal to one unexcused absence.

If your child is going to miss class, please contact your teacher or the RE Office by email or phone at: religiouseducation@corpuschristisr.org, or (703.378.1037). For an absence not to count against your child, please provide us with the reason for their absence. Sickness, Family Emergencies, and Mandatory School Assignments for a grade (i.e. Band Rehearsals, etc.) are the only legitimate reasons for an absence to be excused. Sports and non-graded extracurricular activities do not count as excused absences.
